




## Permit questionnaire Montreal

In Canada the laws applying to heavy vehicles are different from in the United-States and vary from province to province. In Quebec the USDOT is not valid; you will need a Quebec NIR. The NIR applies to any equipment that has a gross vehicle weight (according to manufacturing) equal or over 4 500 KG (9 920 LBS). To help us determine which permits you require, please answer the following questions:

1. Do you have a NIR? Yes No
2. List your USDOT number: \_\_\_\_\_
3. What is the name showing on the vehicle door? \_\_\_\_\_
4. Do you have Quebec listed on your cab card (QC or PQ)? Yes No  
*Note: you should read the total (tractor-trailer) number of axles, not only 3*
5. Will you enter the province of Quebec with a tri axle tractor? Yes No  

6. Do you have a valid NY HUT permit for the trucks going to Tremblant? Yes No
7. Do you have New York listed on your cab card? Yes No
8. Will you travel in any other province? Yes No
9. Do you have a SCAC code? Yes No

10. Quebec and other Canadian provinces have specific laws about tractor and trailer configurations. Please see attached sheet (QUEBEC MEASUREMENTS REGULATIONS).

If you answered yes to question 1 or 4 OR answered no to question 2, 3 or 5 please advise us, as more permits and information is required.

With that information, we will be able to send you other forms, which will ask only for the information that we require for your specific situation.
