Re: Cumulative Updates

The following corrections, additions (where shown in red) or deletions are made to the 2016 IMSA Sporting Regulations & Series Supplementary Regulations for the Porsche GT3 Cup USA:

29.1.1. (SSR) Porsche GT3 Cup Cars registered for an IMSA Event must participate only in Porsche GT3 Cup Challenge Official Sessions unless prior approval is granted in writing by IMSA.

6.9.3. **GT3 Cup USA – Decal Placement Description**

Table: US Flags or Driver Nationality Flags

6.9.9. B-Pillar Flags (IMSA or Team Provided)

A. Team must use either the IMSA provided US Flag, or a flag of the Driver's nationality as presented on the entry form. Teams intending to use a flag of Driver's nationality must ensure size exactly matches dimensions provided by IMSA. Flag design must be approved in advance by IMSA.

B. Flag must be located on B-Pillar according to Fig. 1A and Fig. 1B.

6.10.4. GT3 Cup Canada - Decal Placement Description

Table: Canadian Flags or Driver Nationality Flags

6.10.10. B-Pillar Flags (IMSA or Team Provided)

A. Team must use either the IMSA provided Canadian Flag, or a flag of the Driver's nationality as presented on the entry form. Teams intending to use a flag of Driver's nationality must ensure size exactly matches dimensions provided by IMSA. Flag design must be approved in advance by IMSA.

B. Flag must be located on B-Pillar according to Fig. 2A, Fig. 2B, or Fig. 2C.

11.1.2. For Events featuring the Platinum and Gold classes only, one (1) "Hard Charger" Award is presented per Race, alternating between Platinum and Gold Cup. For each Event, the Platinum class winner in Race 1 and the Gold class winner in Race 2 receive the award.

A. For Events where the Silver class is contested and in addition to awards outlined in Par. 11.1.2, one (1) "Hard Charger" Award is also presented to the Silver class winner per Race.

11.1.3. Eligibility:

E: Award shall be presented during the podium ceremonies following the conclusion of each Porsche GT3 Cup Challenge Race (alternating between Platinum Cup and Gold Cup classes, and for all Races featuring the Silver class).

11.1.4. **SEASON END HARD CHARGER**

A. There will be a season ending “Hard Charger” Award presented to the Driver that advanced the most total positions in the Platinum, Gold, and Silver classes during the season.

B. To be eligible in the Platinum and Gold classes, the Competitor must have started a minimum of 80% of the Races in the season. To be eligible in the Silver class, the Competitor must have started a minimum of 75% of the Races in the season.

The 2016 IMSA Sporting Regulations and Series Supplementary Regulations for the Porsche GT3 Cup Challenge USA By Yokohama Championship have been updated with the information herein and reissued as of 30 March 2016.
