- 9 - **EVENT:** Rounds 9 and 10 of the Ultra 94 Porsche GT3 Cup Challenge Canada by Yokohama at GP3R is sanctioned by IMSA and held under the IMSA RULES.
- 9.4.6 - **Entries Closing:** Tue., Jul. 24, 2018. Late entries per Art. 4.3.
- 9.4.11 - **Number of Cars admitted**
A. Practice sessions: 33 Maximum
B. Qualifying sessions: 33 Maximum
C. Race: 33 Maximum
- 9.4.13 - **Impound:** IMSA Technical Compound in the Paddock per the Technical Department.
- 19 - **Event Logistics:** Exclusively under the direction of and assigned by IMSA. Refer to schedule for Series paddock load-in times.
Load out: Team and vendor transporters must remain in place in the paddock until Sunday. GP3R security personal will indicate the directions to exit the site safely.

- 10. Pit Vehicles:** One (1) per entered Car, with a pass required from the GP3R track registration office. Pit vehicles must be operated by a licensed driver 18 years or more in age. Motorscooters and bicycles permitted in the Paddocks only. 10 MPH speed limit in Paddock and pit areas.
- 11. False Grid:** On the road leading to pit lane entrance.
- 12. Spotter Passes:** N/A
- 13. Radio License Info:** All US based Teams must acquire a Short Term Radio License from Industry Canada to operate in Canada. Information at imsacompetitors.com.
- 14. Facility Restrictions:** Mini motorcycles (pocket bikes) prohibited. Paddocks closed from 10:00 pm until 6:00 am nightly. Detached trailers must have 2' square by ¾" plywood under landing gear. Staking pavement prohibited. Pets must be on a leash.
- 15. Parking Procedure:** IMSA Annual Parking Passes are not honored at this Event. Passenger cars prohibited in the Paddock. Each Entry receives one (1) infield parking pass for a designated Competitor parking space. Each Entry receives (2) outside parking passes for the P12 Lot. Access via Des Forges Boulevard (North direction) to De La Terrière St., turn right on De La Terrière. Follow signs to P12 parking. Access to Paddock using Ryan Walkway Bridge at Turn 8.
- 16. Additional Information:** Additional maps, forms and information at imsacompetitors.com.
- 17. Canadian Taxes:** Canada has a goods and services tax (GST) on many items such as accommodations and most goods to be used primarily outside Canada. Americans visiting Canada can keep receipts, file a claim and be reimbursed for the taxes. Information kits available at the border.
