IPC TRANSPORTER GARAGE LOAD-IN:

- IPC Load-In begins at 1:00 PM on Thursday January 4th
- Transporter staging is at Speedway Gate 70 off of Midway Blvd.
- Gate 70 is open from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm on Wed., Jan. 3 and reopens at 6:00 am on Thu., Jan. 4.
- Early arrivals may go to Lot 2 on International Speedway Blvd. (ISB), see diagram included with this mailing.
- If parked in Lot 2, you must stage at Speedway Gate 70 before 12:00 pm Thu., Jan. 4
- Transporters must be in the staging lot monitoring CB channel 40 for instructions before 12:30 PM
- NO personal Vehicles in paddock / garage during Load In.

GARAGE:

- IPC will be in the Blue open garages for this event. IPC Garage assignment are noted on the garage floor.

TEAM PARKING:

No Parking Pass required with VALID Credential.

- IPC parking is in the infield prior to the Main Paddock Entrance between Lake Lloyd Road and Road Course Turn 3.

TEAM MANAGER & DRIVER MEETINGS:

- In Speedway Meeting Room located outside the blue garage fence in between the Blue and Yellow garage.

IPC TECHNICAL FORUM:

MOTORIZED PIT EQUIPMENT:

- NO 2 wheeled equipment is allowed in the paddock or pit lane areas per DIS.

LOAD OUT:

- Transporters must not move in the paddock Saturday or Sunday until the times listed on the official schedule
- All transporters must vacate the paddock by 7:00pm Sunday January 7th

TRANSPORTER STAY OVER:

FROM TURN 4 TUNNEL

- Exit Tunnel make a left turn
- Drive behind the Tours Building
- Enter Stadium thru east Service Level entrance
- Follow signs to designated parking area
- ★ Take service elevator at Chevrolet Injector to Level 4
- ★ On Level 4 walk to Center Injector & take stairs to the roof

FROM TURN 1 TUNNEL

- Exit Tunnel make a left turn, stay left of the ticket canopy
- Drive to the left around the ticket booth
- Enter Stadium thru west Service Level entrance
- Follow signs to designated parking area
- ★ Take service elevator at Chevrolet Injector to Level 4
- ★ On Level 4 walk to Center Injector & take stairs to the roof

FROM GATE 40

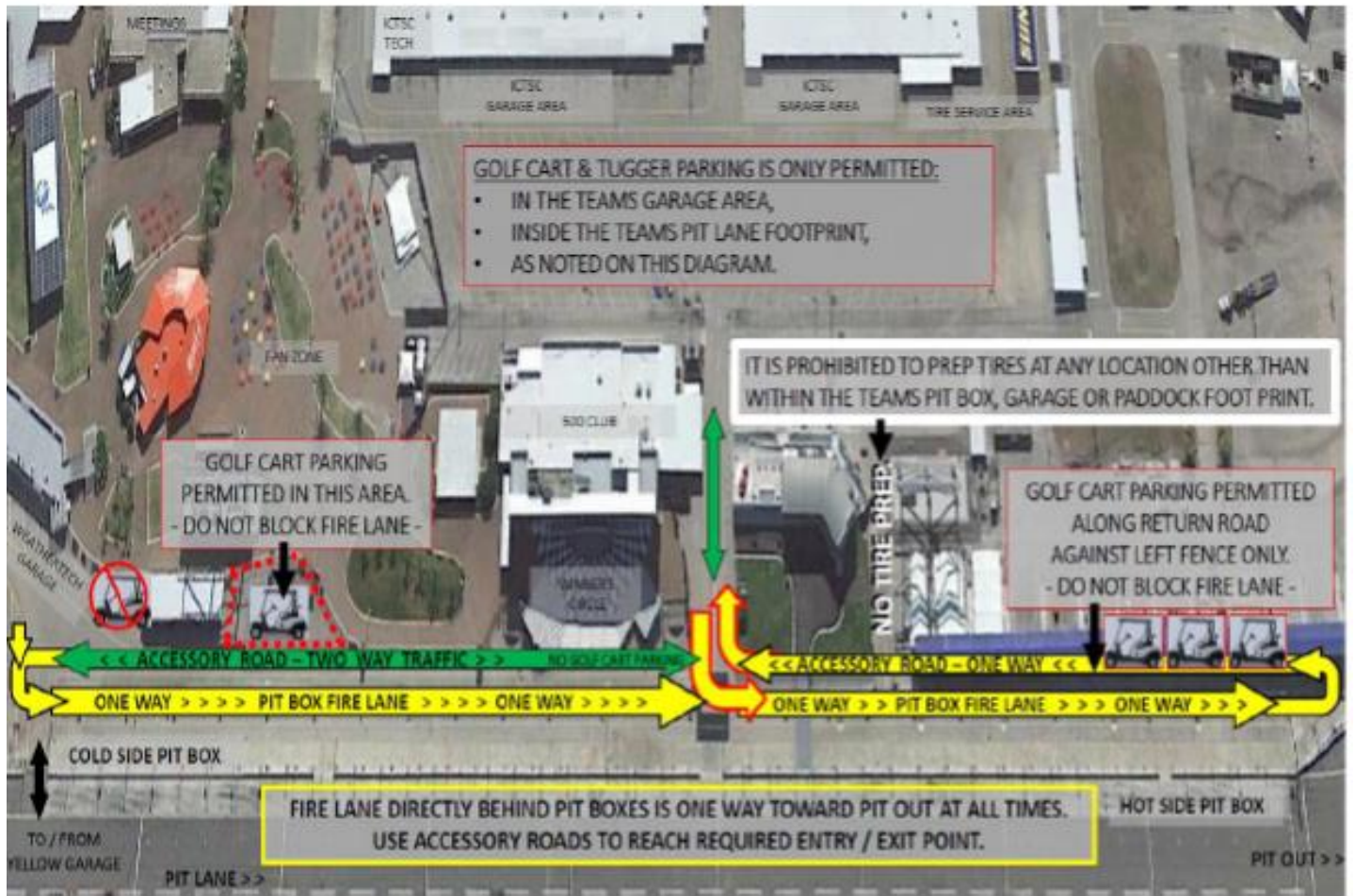
- Enter Gate 40 drive towards Turn 1 Tunnel
- Turn right in Gate 39 and follow signs to Stadium
- Enter Stadium thru west Service Level entrance
- Follow signs to designated parking area
- ★ Take service elevator at Chevrolet Injector to Level 4
- ★ On Level 4 walk to Center Injector & take stairs to the roof

FROM INFIELD VIA CROSSOVER GATES

- Take crossover gates E or D to Level 1
- ★ Follow signs to escalators to Level 4
- ★ On Level 4 walk to Center Injector & take stairs to the roof

- FOLLOW SIGNAGE ON SERVICE LEVEL
- HAVE CREDENTIALS VISIBLE & WHEN ENTERING STADIUM BE PREPARED TO SHOW CREDENTIALS
- ALL VEHICLES WILL BE CHECKED
