Disclaimer: This form is provided as a guideline to be used where a designated power of attorney is desired to act on behalf of an applicant/licensee.

INCLUSIONS: signing and submitting applications for new stations, or to modify the parameters of existing stations, including licence or frequency record cancellations. Also included are the submission of ancillary forms such as Environmental Information, Municipal Land-Use Consultation Attestation, Safety Code 6 Information, and Spectrum Utilization Plans. Documentation requiring a signature may be photocopied, and may be submitted by regular mail, fax, or email (bearing electronic signature).

EXCLUSIONS: Licence conditions and acceptance of financial responsibility for authorizations issued prior to conclusion of International Frequency Coordination are binding upon the applicant/licensee and therefore must be reviewed and signed by the applicant/licensee. The Power of Attorney does not extend to the service provider/installer or representative in these exclusions.

NOTES:

- All Power of Attorney forms must specify a reasonable expiration date. An expiration date can coincide with a project length, under normal circumstances a reasonable period of time is 2 to 3 years.
- The Applicant/Licensee and the Service Provider/Installer should be prepared to submit a copy of a validated Power of Attorney with every transaction separately (joint submissions can use one Power of Attorney).
