Re: IWSC Prototype Class Technical Regulations Update: Nose Mounted Cameras

Please find the below update to the IWSC P Class Technical Regulations, clarifying TR Art. 10.9 regarding Nose Mounted Cameras, as well as the attached diagrams. This update is effective immediately upon publication.

10.9. In-Car Camera Car Mounted Cameras

- 10.9.1. Cars may be required to carry a cockpit mounted in-Car-Camera (ICC).
- 10.9.2. Cars must carry either a Nose Mounted Camera or IMSA Specified Dummy Nose Camera.
 - a. Entrants NOT carrying a Nose Mounted Camera must install the Dummy Nose Camera as illustrated in the drawings attached to these Technical Regulations
- 10.9.3. Entrants carrying any camera must cooperate with the official broadcaster in the installation of the camera, including the provision of power for the equipment.
 - a. Camera may require a battery pack
 - b. Cars equipped with a cockpit mounted ICC must display the Car number in the ICC's home position field of vision.
 - c. ICC must not be removed or disabled by the Entrant for any Session.
